Europe: 11 PhD positions in the IMforFUTURE EU Marie Skłodowska-Curie Innovative Training Network. ASEAN Students Eligible. Deadline 31 August



The Innovative training in methods for future data (IMforFUTURE) is a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Innovative Training Network (MSCA-ITN-ETN). They offer 11 PhD positions students in statistics (4 positions), integrated data analysis (3 positions), glycoproteomics and genetics (2 positions) and glycoproteomics analysis (2 positions). The aim is to integrate genetics, glycomics, and epigenomics datasets into systems biology for ageing by developing innovative methods for high throughput omics and for integrative analysis of omics data. France: AgreenSkills+ Post Doctoral Fellowships in Food, Agriculture, Nutrition, Environment, and Animal Health.. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 13 October, 2017



AgreenSkills+ is open to young experienced and independent researchers with up to 10 years post PhD research experience. There are no special requirements regards nationality, gender or country of origin. The mainly aim of those programmes is to attract the best young and experienced researchers from around the world. The **Incoming fellowships** offer ASEAN researchers an opportunity to undertake a research project within one of the 300 Agreenium-IAVFF members' receiving labs in France. Details [here](#).

Europe: 24 Prestigious Postdoctoral Fellowships in Photonics. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 2 October.



The MULTIPLY Postdoctoral Fellowship Programme in Photonics is a Marie Skłodowska-Curie (MSCA) COFUND Action supporting international researcher mobility and training. Applicants from any part of the world can apply, and can choose their research destination and research topic.. 9 European research institutes as well as research institutes from China and Saudi Arabia are participating in this programme. GERMANY – Development-Related Postgraduate Courses (EPOS). ASEAN researchers eligible. Rolling Deadline



With its development-oriented postgraduate study programmes, the DAAD promotes the training of specialists from developing and newly industrialised countries. The scholarships offer foreign graduates from all disciplines and with at least two years' professional experience the chance to take a postgraduate or Master's degree at a German university, and in exceptional cases a doctoral degree. Depending on academic level DAAD supports monthly payments of 750 euros for graduates or 1,000 euros for doctoral candidates as well as a insurance and travel costs. Details [here](#).

Italy: Jean Monnet Postdoctoral Fellowships. Deadline 25 October



The Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies (RSCAS) offers one or two-year fellowships to postdocs of all nationalities who have obtained their doctorate more than 5 years prior to the start of the fellowship. The three main research themes of the RSCAS are: Integration, Governance and Democracy; Regulating Markets and Governing Money; and 21st Century World Politics and Europe. Details [here](#).

Newton Fund Researcher Links Travel Grants. Researchers from Indonesia and Philippines Eligible. Deadline 19 September



These grants provide financial support for early-career researchers to undertake an international research placement to strengthen links for future collaboration, build research capacity in developing economies, and enhance the researcher's career opportunities. Researchers that reside in the UK can apply for funding to visit a university or research institution in one of the partner countries, and those residing in one of the partner countries can apply for funding to come to the UK. United Kingdom: Newton Fund Institutional Links Programme. Thai Researchers Eligible. Deadline 19 September



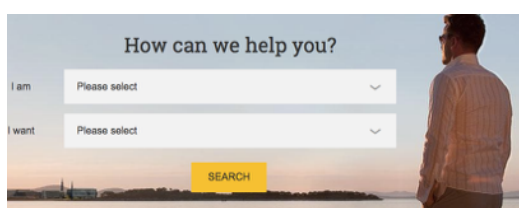
Newton Institutional Links aims to build UK-partner country research and innovation collaborations centred on shared research and innovation challenges, which have direct relevance to social welfare and economic development. Seed funding of £50,000 - £300,000 to initiate and support the joint development of research and innovation collaborations between the UK and partnering research groups or institutions. Newton Fund Researcher Links Regional Workshops bring together early-career researchers from the UK and other regional partner countries to allow them to make international connections that can improve the quality of their research.
